Significant Achievement

- **Field Day on pigeon Pea**

Field day on pigeon pea was organized on 06.01.2018 at Bavanbir village of Sangrampur tahsil at Mr. Digambar Kalpande's farm. Mr. S.M. Umale SMS Agronomy elaborate the aim and objectives of field day programme. Mr. A.T. Gabhane, Programme Coordinator guided the farmers about value addition and processing of pulses.

After this a crop cut of 5mt x 5mt was taken and measures the number of pods and farmers realised increase in yield upto 27% in demonstration plot as compare to check plot. Farmers gave their feedback about variety PKV TARA as a high yielding, wilt resistant variety, use of bio-fertilizer hasten the germination and profuse growth, 45 farmers and officers from State Agril Dept was present for this programme. KVK appealed CFLD farmers to preserve the seed of this variety for sowing purpose.



- **Vocational Training on Protected Vegetable Cultivation**

KVK organized five days vocation training on Protected vegetable cultivation at KVK during 08-12 January 2018. To improve vegetable cultivation and reduce pest and disease management, protected cultivation is gaining importance. More farmers from district asking about requiring vocational training. Taking this point into consideration 5 days vocational training was organized at KVK.

In this training 15 participants from Shegaon, Sangrampur, Jalgaon, Nandura and Malkapur tahsils were participated. During this training need of protected cultivation, soil and climate management, pest and disease management, special horticultural practices to improve productivity, marketing strategy topics have been studied, During this training study tour was also organized at Mr. Shashikant Fundkars, Po. Yeulkhed , Tq: Shegaon. During this visit farmers interacted with successful growers. During this training Bank Manager, vegetable seed producing farmers interacted with trainees. On concluding session two trainees immediately started construction of Shednet house on their field.
